

#### A Message From Chaplin Craig

My mother brought some old photographs with her on a recent stay. One night, she called over my two daughters, ages 6 and 3, and asked them if they could identify any of the three children pictured in the black and white photograph she held in her hand. Three young girls, about my daughters' ages sat smiling on the edge of a top bunk at bedtime, each of them clutching a teddy bear or doll. What my daughters didn't know is that the one on the far left was my mom. They couldn't figure it out. When the truth was revealed, they were still a bit suspicious. Could Grandma have really once been a girl their age?

Almost every resident I speak with tells me that they never thought they'd get to be as old as they are. "Old" was an adjective that always applied to other people. Time moves in a curios way. Sometimes it seems to move all too slowly. At other times, it can pass so quickly that we only recognize just how far we've come by looking backward.

Age is a lot more than just a number. Rather, it's a testament to everything that we've already been though and our ability to navigate all life's changes with purpose and persistence. The children in our lives may not always recognize us in those old photographs. We may not always recognize ourselves in the mirror. But time has made us who we are. When we stoop to reflect on our lives,, we can celebrate wherever we are right now-no matter our age! -and share with others what we've learned and what we've been through in all the years past.




