



Spiritual Matters

A Message From Chaplin Craig

Long before his days on the acclaimed children's television series *Mister Rogers' Neighborhood,* Fred Rogers was a child who got scared sometimes. Sometimes the news of the day felt overwhelming. It was in those times when he received some powerful advice from his mother Nancy. Later in life, he recounted her words of wisdom:

"When I was a boy and I would see scary things in the news, my mother would say to me, 'Look for the helpers. You will always find people who are helping.' To this day, especially in times of 'disaster,' I remember my mother's words and I am always comforted by realizing that there are still so many helpers – so many caring people in this world."

They may not often capture the spotlight or receive the most prominent news coverage, but there are always the helpers. Anywhere there is tragedy or disaster, crisis or chaos, alongside those things there are also always people who are caring for their neighbors and those in need, offering compassion and forgiveness in the face of evil, and doing the hard work of peace. Any crisis can bring out the worst in us and also the best in us. It's true that every day there is more bad news. It's also true that every day there are people doing good despite the bad. We won't see them if we're not looking for them. But if we are looking for them, we will find the helpers - "so many caring people in this world" - everywhere.


